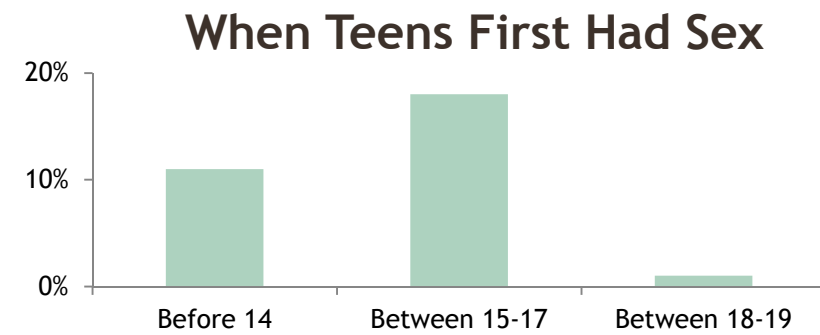
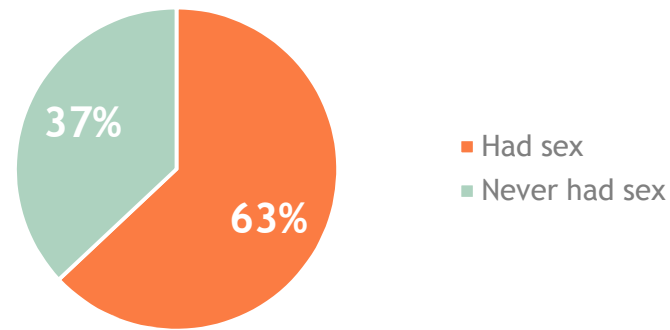


Hartford Teen Pregnancy and STI Facts



Hartford Teen Pregnancy Prevention Initiative

About Us

The City of Hartford's teen pregnancy prevention initiative is a 5 year project that was created to educate youth about teen pregnancy prevention using community wide initiatives. The project aims to reach 800 youth each year for four years for a total of 3200 youth. Youth served in this project range from 13-19 years old and reside in the City of Hartford.



Teen Births

Hartford	1 in 20
Connecticut	1 in 63
United States	1 in 33

In 2011, **248** babies in Hartford were born to teen mothers

Teens & STIs

Number of teen STI cases in Hartford:

Chlamydia: 597
Gonorrhea: 77

1,946 people in Hartford are living with HIV

Hartford Teens

1 in 10 had sex under the influence the last time they had sex

3 in 20 have been pregnant or have gotten someone pregnant

2 in 5 believe that they have no chance of contracting an STI

3 in 4 teens who have had sex say that they have had sex without a condom at least once

1 in 10 have been diagnosed with an STI

1 in 5 sexually active teens have ever been tested for STIs (excluding HIV)
